Compost contains macro nutrients, micro nutrients and a large assortment of beneficial bacteria and fungi.

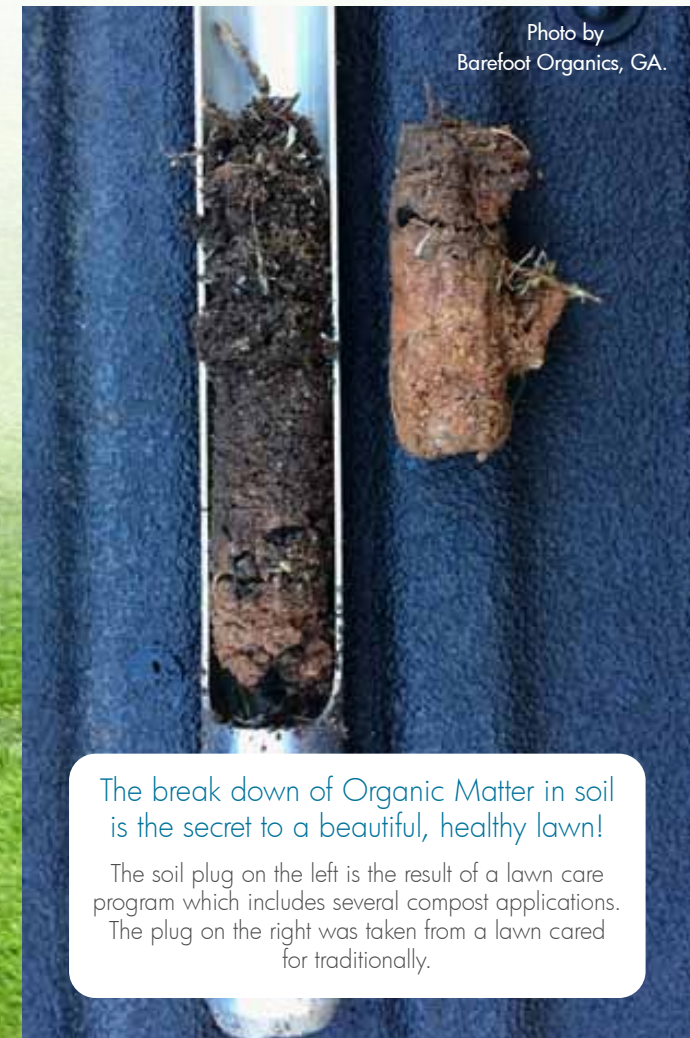
